The American Heart Association/ American Stroke Association honored the UF Health Shands Comprehensive Stroke Center with its Get with The Guidelines Stroke Gold Performance Award.

The Stroke Center also received the Target: Stroke Honor Roll, an elevated distinction. Only current Get with The Guidelines Stroke Achievement Award-winning hospitals are eligible for this honor.

The program has received a 5-star rating for stroke care from Healthgrades and accreditation from the Agency for Health Care Administration (AHCA) as a Primary and Comprehensive Stroke Center and primary stroke center criteria by the Joint Commission on Accreditation of Healthcare Organizations (JCAHO).

The UF Department of Neurology and the UF Health Shands Comprehensive Stroke Center offer two Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME) accredited fellowships in cerebrovascular disease.

The UF Department of Neurosurgery is home to one of just two neurosurgical endovascular fellowships approved by the ACGME in the country.
